



Small Quantity Hazardous Waste Generator Collection Event

Looking for a way to responsibly dispose of your business's hazardous waste?

Mecklenburg County Solid Waste is hosting a Hazardous Waste Collection Event for businesses that qualify as a *Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator* (or CESQG) under the *Resource Conservation and Recovery Act* (40 CFR §261.5). To qualify as a CESQG, a business must generate less than 220 pounds of hazardous waste and less than 2.2 pounds of acute hazardous waste each month.

The CESQG Hazardous Waste Collection event will take place **Wednesday, July 19, 2017**. This one-day collection event will be managed by *ECOFLO, Inc.*, a licensed hazardous waste processing company in North Carolina. There is a \$75 handling fee for all materials, plus disposal fees. All transactions will be handled by *ECOFLO, Inc.* **This event is by appointment only.**

Event FAQ:

- ***Do I need an appointment?***
 - Yes, you must schedule an appointment with *ECOFLO, Inc.*, to participate in this event.
- ***What types of payments do you take?***
 - *ECOFLO, Inc.*, will accept Company Check or Credit Card (3% fee added).
- ***If my business is located outside of the county of Mecklenburg can I participate in this event?***
 - No, this event is only open to businesses within Mecklenburg County.
- ***Are there fees in addition to the \$75 handling fee?***
 - Yes, depending on what type of waste you are bringing there will be additional fees.
- ***Is there a limit on volume?***
 - There may be based on classification. CESQGs can generate no more than 100 kg (220 pounds) of hazardous waste and 1 kg (2.2 pounds) of acute hazardous waste each month. RCRA also prohibits CESQGs from storing more than 1,000 kg. (2,200 lbs.) of hazardous waste on site at any time.
- ***What types of Hazardous Waste Can I Not Bring?***
 - The event will not accept pharmaceutical waste or materials that are explosive, radioactive or infectious.
